

STUDY HALL PROGRAM

Description: The Study Hall Program at Christ Community Church is a free after-school community outreach program for youth ages 6 through 14. Children are invited to study at the church with other youth, while accompanied by their parents/guardians. At each study hall session, young people will learn one study skill or strategy to assist them in raising their academic achievement. The program is sponsored in partnership between Christ Community Church and Competitive Educational Consulting. The pastors of Christ Community Church are Dr. Charles, Co-Pastor April Fox, and Associate Pastor Carla Hairston. The CEO/President of Competitive Educational Consulting is Dr. Pat Dingle. The Study Hall runs promptly from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. Parents who need to arrive at 7:00 p.m. due to work schedules will be accommodated. However the program will promptly start and end at the designated times to avoid interference with the participants' regular school assignments. The study hall will be limited to the study hall location and restrooms. Participants and their parents/guardians are expected to remain in these areas. Also, a condition of the program is that all participants and their guests (parents/guardians) will be civil and courteous at all times.

Application and Enrollment Period: The Study Hall Program will be lead by Dr. Pat Dingle, a retired highly qualified teacher, with over 30 years of experience. If you are interested in this program, children may be enrolled by completing an application and receiving signed permission from their parent or legal guardian. There will be two sessions annually. The program does not operate when the Prince George's County Public Schools are closed. Also, in the event that the School System is closed and evening activities are cancelled, the Study Hall Program will also be cancelled. Please be sure to check your local news stations.



Applications will be due by the date listed on the application. There are sessions per year. An application is required for each session, as well as, one application per child.

Program Acceptance and Certificate: After applications are received, participants will be notified if they are admitted to the program. Children from Christ Community Church have first priority. To ensure that more students have the opportunity to participate, families from the community may enroll no more than two children during an enrollment period. Participants are expected to attend regularly since space is limited. The students attending all sessions in a year will receive a certificate.
